

Start by heading northwest on A1036 toward Rougier St.

Continue straight onto A1036/Gillygate.

At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto A1036/Haxby Rd.

Continue to follow A1036, passing through one roundabout.

Turn left onto B1363/Towthorpe Rd.

Continue to follow B1363.

Turn right onto Moorcroft Rd.

Woodthorpe Dental Centre will be on your left at 47 Moorcroft Rd.

From York Railway Station:

Head northeast on Station Rd toward Station Rise.

Turn right onto Station Rise.

Continue onto Lendal.

Turn left onto Museum St.

At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto A1036/Gillygate.

Follow steps 3-8 from the City Centre directions above.

From York Outer Ring Road (A1237):

Take the exit toward A19/Shipton Rd from the A1237.

At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto A19/Shipton Rd.

Continue on A19, passing through one roundabout.

Turn right onto Moorcroft Rd.

Woodthorpe Dental Centre will be on your left at 47 Moorcroft Rd.
